#### **PROGRAM TESTIMONIAL**

Janet is a single mother of four with a heartbreakingly familiar story — a hardworking parent doing everything she can for her family and still ending up short a bag of groceries. She visited our **Food Pantry** to bridge the gap, a familiar face we saw from time to time. One day, Janet came to us in distress. She had just given birth and was on unpaid leave. Her rent was due, her fridge was nearly empty, and two of her children were showing signs of disability. She was dispirited. Her children's future seemed uncertain. Janet had held her family up alone for a long time, but the weight had become too much. What started as a quiet struggle spiraled into a crisis. Staff helped Janet lower her rent, find diapers, connect with mental health supports, and enroll her kids in preschool programs that meet their unique needs. Janet's outlook transformed from despair to hope.

### **PROGRAM TESTIMONIAL**

When Kabul, Afghanistan, fell to the Taliban in 2021, Mohammad made the impossible choice to flee for safety with his six-year-old son, leaving behind his wife and two toddler daughters. After arriving in Syracuse through our **Refugee Resettlement Program**, he found himself in a new country, raising his son alone, learning to cook for the first time, and searching for work that'd allow him to be both parent and provider.

With our help, Mohammad found flexible employment and childcare support, and began building a new life. He applied for asylum, and has started the process to reunite his family.

### **PROGRAM TESTIMONIAL**

When Maria came to our **Mental Health Counseling** team, she was experiencing anxiety and flashbacks following a traumatic house fire. Everyday triggers—like smoke, fire drills, or even sunlight—left her feeling unsafe and constantly on edge. Through trauma-focused clinical treatment, Maria began to address the images, sounds, and beliefs that caused the trauma. Over several months, her sense of fear transformed into one of safety and resilience.

Today, Maria can engage in everyday activities—lighting candles, cooking, and handling fire drills—without fear. Her story is a powerful reminder of the healing that is possible through compassionate, evidence-based mental health care.






