



Housing Services Center: Jeff's Story

Just before the holidays, Jeff moved in as one of the first residents of our 8 Permanent Supportive Housing single bedroom apartments.

He became homeless in 2022 after his mental health struggles separated him from his family. Jeff found his way to the Catholic Charities Men's Shelter, and confided in our staff that he was living in constant fear of being on his own. Jeff's case manager and our shelter's Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner worked with him consistently. Jeff agreed to begin medication therapy for mental illness.

Despite his mental health improvements, Jeff's fear of living alone persisted. In December 2023, he was placed in one of the Catholic Charities Housing Services Center apartments.

He was hesitant, but our agency's support system has been supportive and collaborative. Our staff have welcomed Jeff, assessing his needs, validating his concerns, and advocating for Jeff to be the best version of himself.

Empowered by support, Jeff has been living independently for nearly two months.
